

Arizona Public Law #1008 Arizona is Not for Sale

We, The Arizona Assembly(c), a member of The United States of America(c), unincorporated, with lawful superior concurrent general jurisdiction over land and soil, sea, and air in Arizona, hereby issue a Public Notice to all people, that it is declared and recorded by roll call vote, Arizona Public Law 1008.

Arizona Public Law 1008 prohibits foreign entities from owning land on Arizona. The Arizona Assembly(c) may vote to allow an entity to rent or lease the land. Arizona is Not for sale.

Furthermore, all entities operating on our land and soil, are liable for any and all activities, and the consequences of those activities, that result in any physical, physiological, or psychological damage by depriving Americans of our right to bountiful health as given by our Creator.

We, the People of Arizona, are not subject to legislation passed by our employees for the purpose of regulating their own operations.

This is concurrent with Public Laws A1010121, A1010224 and A1010124 passed by all 50 states of The United States of America(c), unincorporated. These public laws apply to all Americans and U.S. Citizens in every state.
