

Arizona Public Law #1010 Unconscionable Contracts

We, The Arizona Assembly(c), a member of The United States of America(c), unincorporated, with lawful superior concurrent general jurisdiction over land and soil, sea, and air on Arizona, hereby issue a Public Notice to all persons and people, that it is declared and recorded by roll call vote, Arizona Public Law #1010.

Arizona Public Law #1010 declares: As unconscionable contracts of any kind are unlawful and null and void for fraud, any agreement that does not provide full disclosure, consent, and wet ink signature(s) of all persons/Persons involved is null and void. This includes any agreement reached under color of law, such as the "birth certificate," which applies Naturalization to "US Citizenship" of every American at birth without the knowledge and/or consent of the child or child's parents. Any action or assumption based on an unconscionable contract, such as the "birth certificate," et al., is fraudulent, and any ramifications of said action or assumption are hereby null and void.

This law also establishes that all births, deaths, marriages and other licenses and registrations of any kind cease and desist and shall instead be recorded on the public record effective immediately, per American Common Law - the Law of the Land since October 5th of 2024.

All corporations and entities operating on our land soil are liable for any and all activities, and the consequences of those activities, that result in any physical, physiological, financial or psychological damage to Americans.

We, the People of Arizona, are not subject to legislation passed by our employees for the purpose of regulating their own operations.

This is concurrent with Public Laws A1010121, A1010224 and A1010124 passed by all 50 states of The United States of America, unincorporated. These public laws apply to all Americans in every state. This is also concurrent with Arizona Public Laws #1001, 1002, 1003, 1004, 1005, 1006, 1007, 1008 and 1009, passed unanimously by the People of The Arizona Assembly(c) and published on www.thearizonaassembly.org website.
